



Fresh Cut 2010 Rules

Fresh Cut is a one-hour documentary that features original works from high school students within KLRN's viewing area.

Please review all rules before submitting an entry. Any submissions that do not meet all rules will be automatically disqualified.

1. All **entries must be received by KLRN by 5:00 PM on Friday, March 26, 2010**. No exceptions will be made for entries received beyond that date. Early submissions are encouraged.
2. Entries **must be submitted on DVD**. No other format is accepted. Any entry not submitted on DVD will be automatically disqualified. Teachers are encouraged, but not required, to submit all entries from their school on one DVD.
3. Each entry must include the completed **Official Entry Form**. Entry forms can be downloaded from the KLRN Fresh Cut webpage at www.klrn.org/freshcut. Any entry submitted without the completed Official Entry Form will be automatically disqualified.
4. Any entry containing **copyrighted materials** used without permission will be automatically disqualified. To ensure acceptance, students are encouraged to use original music or music from the public domain, such as titles from www.classicalarchives.com or www.freemusic.com. Any submissions with copyrighted music are not eligible for presentation on the Internet (including the Viewer's Choice Award).
5. Entries **must be submitted through the high school or home schooling organization**. Eligible students must be currently enrolled in a high school or home schooling organization within KLRN's viewing area.
6. A school may submit up to **five entries**. Teachers should screen all entries and submit only the best ones—up to five entries per school.
7. Each entry must be kept to a maximum of **five minutes** in length. Entries that are longer than five minutes will be automatically disqualified. Selected pieces may be shown in their entirety or only a portion may be shown during the program. Selected pieces must comply with copyright permissions to be available for streaming via the KLRN website in their entirety.
8. Although KLRN attempts to include at least one entry from each school/district/home schooling organization that submits student work, quality issues or other constraints may not allow for equal time for

all schools/districts/home schooling organizations.

9. Judging will occur in April 2010 and will include both public (online) judging and judging by a panel of experts.
10. Teachers will be notified after the judging (and prior to the airing of *Fresh Cut 2010*) regarding selected and non-selected student works.
11. Tentative broadcast date for *Fresh Cut 2010* is May 2010 (date and time TBA). All conditions of the *Fresh Cut 2010* production are subject to change.
12. Entries selected for *Fresh Cut 2010* will be available for streaming on the Fresh Cut webpage at www.klrn.org/freshcut.
